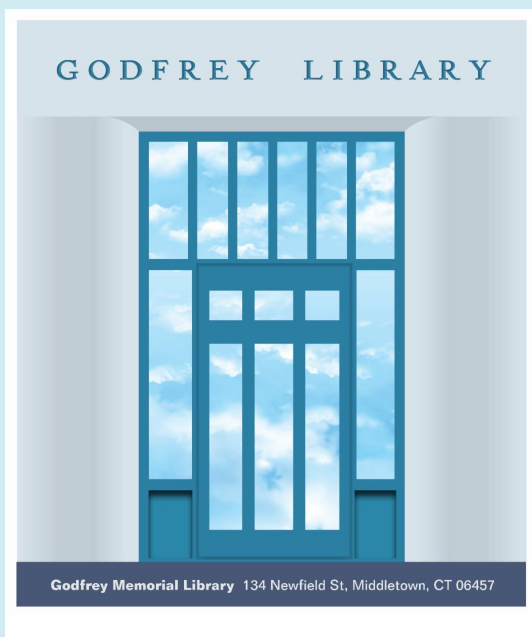
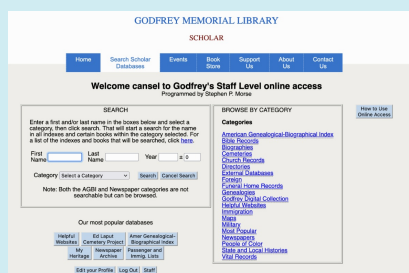

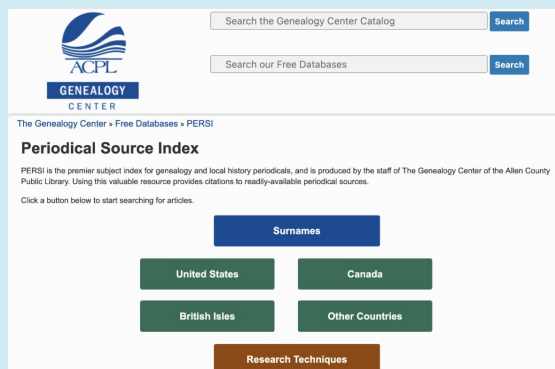


## PERSI is Back Home!
